

"It's not a good idea to have a chill room - it would be nicer to be allowed to use your phone in the classroom."



The equipment and the Smartboards are really great."



In our first grade, we went to Großraming for our "Kennenlerntage". We went hiking and played games in the woods. We enjoyed these days and nearly nobody felt homesick.


